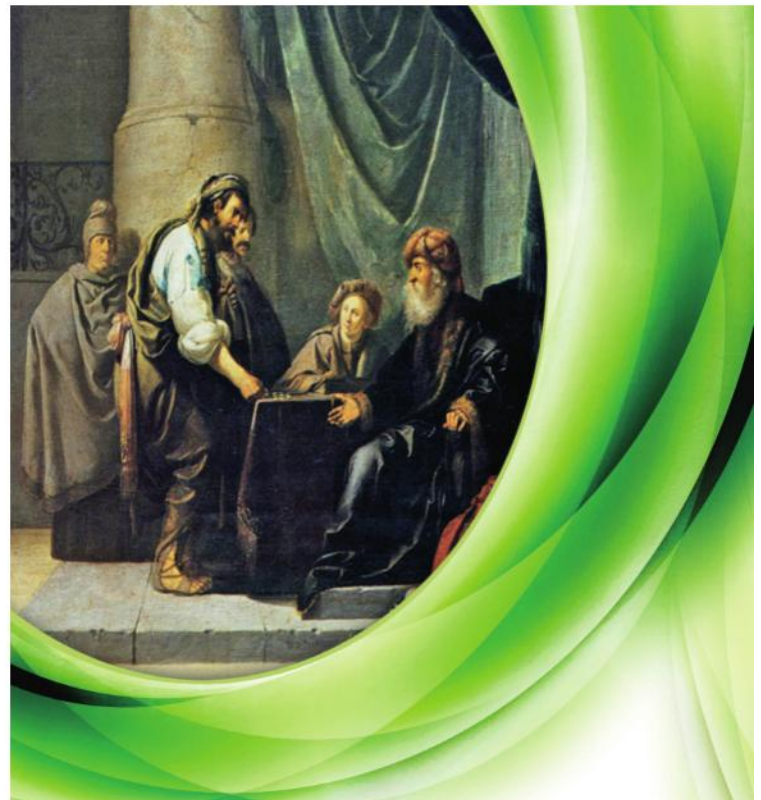

**Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary
Use It or Lose It**

When I hear the Gospel reading for this Sunday, I wonder what that third servant was doing all that time, after he buried the talent he was given. Probably nothing. What strikes me is that the word for money in this reading is “talent,” which in our language is an ability or skill. So maybe this parable can remind us to use our abilities and not let them go to waste.

It is sad to see someone who is not very good at his job just because he never developed his inborn talents. But if you know what gifts or abilities God gave you, you can develop them to be much more than you expected. A person might be strong and fast, but if she exercises and practices, she could be a great athlete. The same with a spiritual gift. Just having one doesn't make you a saint. So how do you know what gifts you have?

First, ask God in your prayers to show you what gifts you have been given. Find a spiritual director, or even your parish priest, and talk about your life, your strengths and weaknesses. Read about saints and how they used their gifts to serve the Lord. Read the scriptures, especially the Acts of the Apostles or the Letters of Paul (e.g., 1 Corinthians 12:1–11). Listen humbly to friends or loved ones who can tell you what strengths they see in you.

Second, look for ways to use your gifts. Check the parish bulletin or website or your diocesan newspaper for activities and organizations that you could take part in. Hospitals, schools, shelters, and nursing homes frequently offer opportunities for volunteers. If one kind of service seems attractive to you, that could be God's way of telling you to try it. On the other hand, a job that seems very challenging could be what you need to stretch your spiritual muscles. Or you may see a need for some service that you can get started in the parish or community.

Just remember that you are called to service by your baptism and confirmation. Don't bury that calling by procrastinating or being afraid to try. Remember the “useless servant” with the one talent who was fearful and lazy (Matthew 25:25–26). At least he can remind us to use it or lose it.

**Trigésimo Tercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
Utilizarlo o perderlo**

Cuando escucho el Evangelio de este domingo, me pregunto qué estaba haciendo ese tercer siervo todo ese tiempo, después de enterrar el talento que le dieron. Lo más probable es que no estaba haciendo nada. Lo que me llama la atención es que la palabra para “dinero” en esta lectura es “talento”, que en nuestro idioma significa una habilidad o destreza. Tal vez esta parábola puede recordarnos que debemos utilizar nuestras habilidades y no dejar que se desperdicien.

Es triste ver a alguien que no es muy bueno en su trabajo simplemente porque nunca desarrolló sus talentos innatos. Pero si sabes cuales dones o habilidades Dios te ha dado, puedes desarrollarlos para que sean mucho más de lo que esperabas. Una persona puede ser fuerte y rápida, pero si hace ejercicio y practica el deporte, podría llegar a ser una gran atleta. Es lo mismo con un don espiritual. Solo tenerlo no te convierte en un santo. Entonces, ¿cómo sabes cuáles dones tienes?

Primero, pídele a Dios en la oración que te demuestre cuáles dones te ha concedido. Busca un director espiritual, o incluso tu párroco, y hablale de tu vida, de tus fortalezas y debilidades. Lee sobre los santos y cómo utilizaron sus dones para servir al Señor. Lee las Escrituras, especialmente los Hechos de los Apóstoles o las Cartas de San Pablo (como 1 Corintios 12,1–11). Escucha con humildad a tus amigos o seres queridos que te pueden decir cuales fortalezas ven en ti.

Segundo, busca diferentes maneras de utilizar tus dones. Consulte el boletín o el sitio web parroquial o el periódico diocesano para encontrar actividades y organizaciones en las que podrías participar. Los hospitales, escuelas, refugios y hogares de ancianos con frecuencia ofrecen oportunidades para voluntarios. Si un tipo de servicio te llama la atención, podría ser que Dios te está llamando a probarlo. Por otro lado, un trabajo que parece un reto podría ser lo que necesitas para estirar tus músculos espirituales. O quizás ves la necesidad de algún servicio que puedes iniciar en la parroquia o en la comunidad.

Acuérdate que por tu bautismo y confirmación eres llamado al servicio. No entierres ese llamado posponiendo las cosas y no tengas miedo de intentar algo. Acuérdate del “siervo inútil” con un solo talento, que era temeroso y perezoso (Mateo 25,25-26). Por lo menos él nos puede recordar que si no lo utilizamos, lo perdemos.
