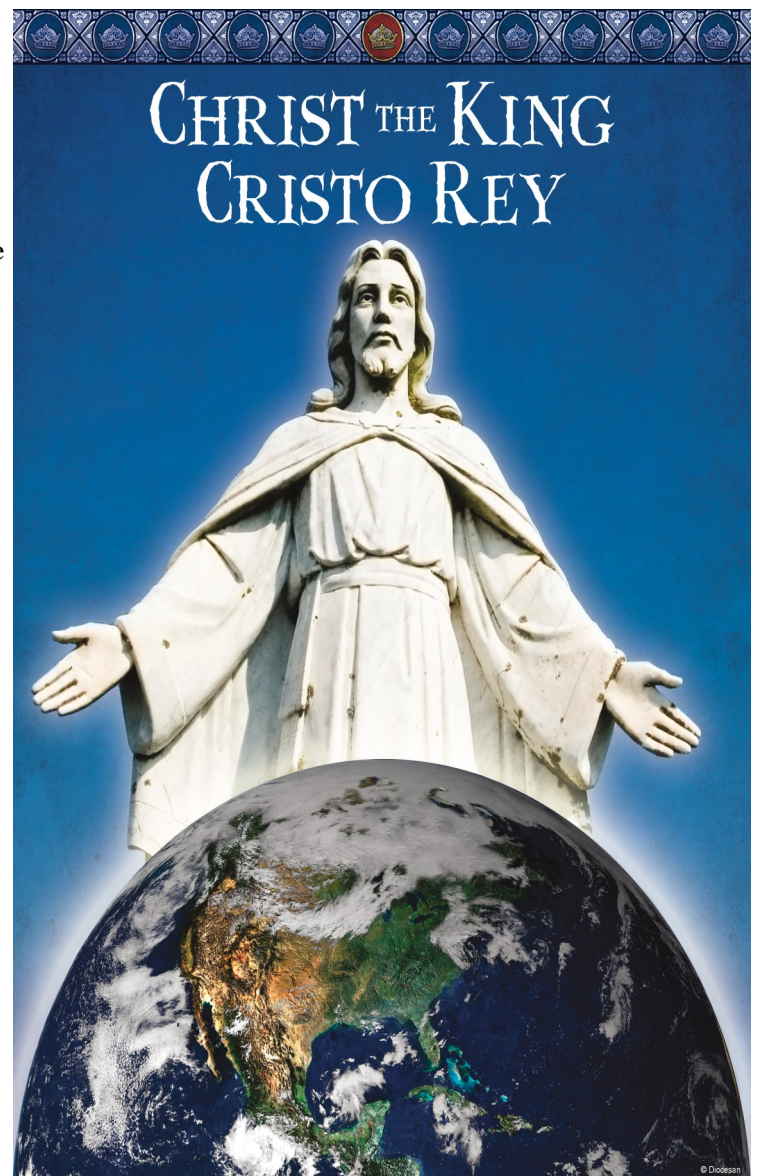

Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Today's Gospel could be seen as an example of what St. Paul is explaining in the second reading. Since death came into the world with the sin of Adam, Christ's death saved us from sin and his resurrection saves us from death. And since Christ had to die before he could rise, the last enemy to be subjected is death; so too do we have to die before we can rise.

When all this happens, God will be seen in all of creation. Jesus will be seen as equal to God, not just a man, but the Son of God. The Gospel gives us the image of a king on his throne, surrounded by his subjects. And then comes the final judgment.

I always thought the point of this parable was that we recognize God in the poor, the sick, the homeless, prisoners, etc. But the people in the parable who helped all those in need did not recognize Christ in the needy. That's why he tells them that whatever we do for "these least ones," we do for Christ.

That is actually good news, because it is not always easy to recognize Christ in others. I used to think that once I start seeing Christ in all people, I'll be more willing to help them. But it also works the other way. When you help someone in need, you begin to see Christ there, too. Whether it is a death-row prisoner or a homeless family, we take that leap of faith to help, not because we see Christ in them but just because they need help. Remember, God forgives and saves us because we need God, not because we deserve it.

Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo

El Evangelio de hoy podría verse como un ejemplo de lo que San Pablo está explicando en la segunda lectura. Dado que la muerte entró al mundo con el pecado de Adán, la muerte de Cristo nos salvó del pecado y su resurrección nos salva de la muerte. Y como Cristo tuvo que morir antes de poder resucitar, el último enemigo a ser sujeto es la muerte; también nosotros tenemos que morir antes de poder resucitar.

Cuando todo esto suceda, todo mostrará la gloria de Dios. Dios será visto en toda la creación. Jesús será visto como igual al Padre, no sólo un hombre, sino el Hijo de Dios. El Evangelio nos presenta la imagen de un rey en su trono, rodeado de sus súbditos. Y luego viene el juicio final. Siempre pensé que el punto de esta parábola era que reconozcamos a Dios en los pobres, los enfermos, los desamparados, los prisioneros, etc., pero las personas de la parábola que ayudaron a todos los necesitados no reconocieron a Cristo en los necesitados. Por eso les dice que todo lo que hagamos por "aquellos más insignificantes", lo hacemos por Cristo.

En realidad, esto es una buena noticia, porque no siempre es fácil reconocer a Cristo en los demás. Solía pensar que una vez que empiece a ver a Cristo en todas las personas, estaría más dispuesto a ayudarlas, pero también funciona al revés. Cuando ayudas a alguien necesitado, comienzas a ver a Cristo allí también. Ya sea un prisionero condenado a muerte o una familia sin hogar, debemos dar ese salto de fe para ayudar, sin saber si alguna vez veremos a Cristo en ellos. Acuérdate que Dios nos perdona y salva porque necesitamos a Dios, no porque lo merezcamos.
