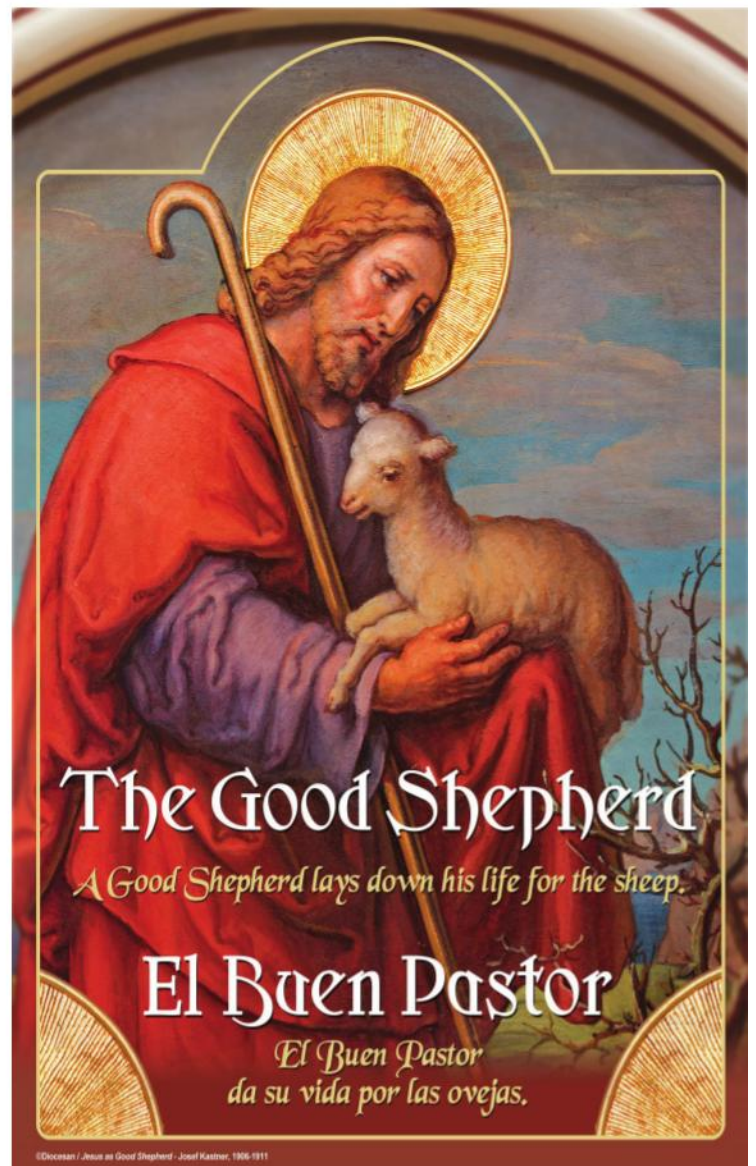

Fourth Sunday of Easter

The Rejected Savior

In the reading from Acts, Peter explains to the leaders of Israel how they cured a crippled man. They probably expected Peter to take credit for the cure, so they were waiting for him to hang himself by his words. Peter, of course, gives the credit to Jesus and then makes two important points.

First he calls Jesus the “stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone.” This quote from Psalm 118 was used often by the early Christians to show that Jesus was rejected by fellow Jews when he was crucified, but was actually doing God’s will when he gave his life on the cross. Thus he became not just a martyr, but the savior of the world. This gave comfort to those who had expected the leaders of Israel to follow Jesus and recognize him as the Messiah. It also told those leaders that they could be forgiven for crucifying Jesus if they would simply repent.

The second point made by Peter was that Jesus is the one and only savior of the world. In those days, the Roman emperor was considered to be a god and was called a savior. Peter says this to the leaders because they had to obey the emperor and his appointed rulers over Israel. While we no longer look to politicians to be saviors, we need to remember that Jesus is **the** Savior: he forgives our sins, shows us how to love God and our neighbors, and hears our prayers. He lives in us to support us when the answer to our prayers is “no.” And in the end, he is with us when we die to bring us to eternal life. When we love others (and are loved by others) we experience a taste of God’s love. Now the choice is yours: to reject the Savior or make Him the cornerstone of your life.

Cuarto domingo de Pascua El Salvador rechazado

En la lectura de los Hechos, Pedro explica a los líderes de Israel cómo curaron a un hombre enfermo. Probablemente esperaban que Pedro se atribuyera el mérito de la cura, y estaban esperando a que se condenara a sí mismo con sus propias palabras. Pedro, por supuesto, le da el crédito a Jesús y luego señala dos puntos importantes.

Primero llama a Jesús “la piedra que ustedes, los constructores, han desechado y que es la piedra angular”. Esta cita del Salmo 118 fue utilizada a menudo por los primeros cristianos para mostrar que Jesús fue rechazado por sus compañeros judíos cuando fue crucificado, pero en realidad estaba haciendo la voluntad de Dios cuando dio su vida en la cruz. Así se convirtió no sólo en un mártir, sino en el salvador del mundo. Esto dio consuelo a quienes esperaban que los líderes de Israel siguieran a Jesús y lo reconocieran como el Mesías. También les dijo a esos líderes que podrían ser perdonados por crucificar a Jesús si simplemente se arrepintieran.

El segundo punto planteado por Pedro fue que Jesús es el único salvador del mundo. En aquellos días, el emperador romano era considerado un dios y llamado salvador. Pedro les dice esto a los líderes porque tenían que obedecer al emperador y a sus gobernantes designados sobre Israel. Si bien ya no buscamos que los políticos sean salvadores, debemos recordar que Jesús es el Salvador. Perdona nuestros pecados, nos muestra cómo amar a Dios y al prójimo y escucha nuestras oraciones. Vive dentro de nosotros para apoyarnos cuando la respuesta a nuestras oraciones es “no”. Y al final, está con nosotros cuando nos morimos para llevarnos a la vida eterna. Cuando amamos a los demás (y somos amados por los demás) experimentamos una muestra del amor de Dios. Ahora la decisión es tuya: rechazar al Salvador o convertirlo en la piedra angular de tu vida.
