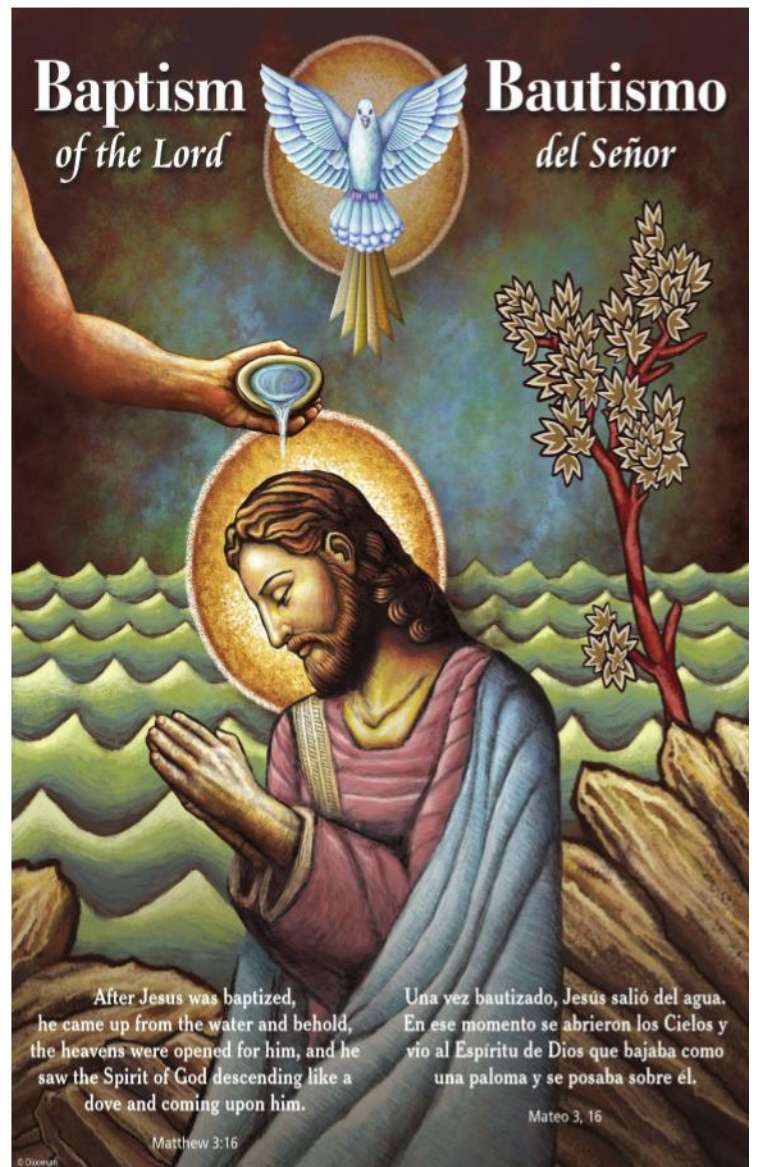

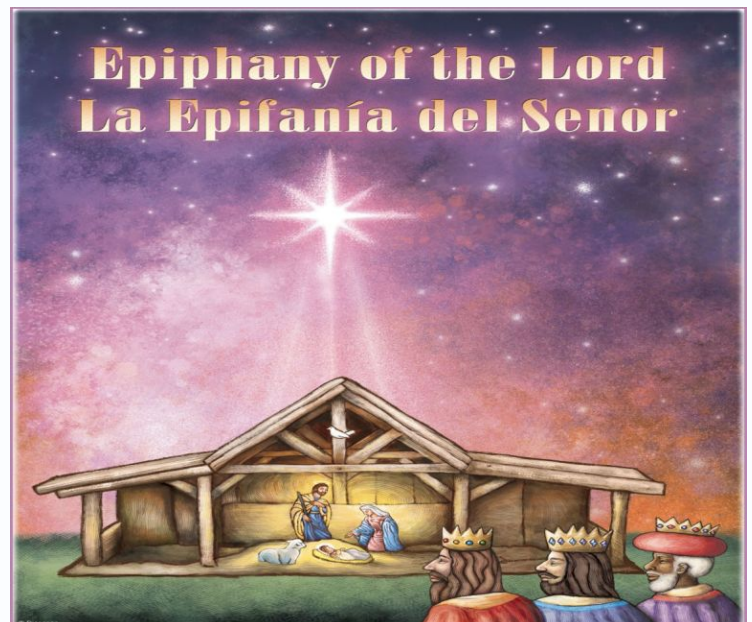

The Epiphany of the Lord Little Drummer Boy

Did you know that the only reason we say that there were three wise men is that they brought three gifts? The Bible never says their number or their names. The gifts tell us about the givers. And these special gifts—gold, frankincense, and myrrh—tell us much.

When one king visited or sent an ambassador to another, he would give a gift of gold to show that he acknowledged the kingship of the other. So the first gift of the wise men tells us they recognized Jesus as King. The second gift is a type of incense, which was used in Jesus time to worship God. So this gift shows the wise men paying homage to Jesus' divinity. The gift of myrrh is oil used to anoint the dying. It reminds us of Jesus suffering and death on the cross.

So what gifts do we have for Jesus? Maybe we can take a hint from the wise men. If we acknowledge Jesus as king, maybe a better gift than gold would be to pledge our obedience to him. Each day we can promise to live our vocation as best we can, to love those around us, and forgive those who hurt us.

A better way than burning incense to pay homage to Jesus' divinity is to take time to pray throughout the day. Some people are able to attend daily Mass, others spend time in adoration before the Eucharist, or even a few minutes of their lunch break to say the rosary.

As for the gift of myrrh, we can give Jesus the crosses we bear each day. When we accept suffering in our lives, especially that caused by our sins, we give ourselves to Jesus as he gave himself for us on the cross.

The song "Little Drummer Boy" reminds us that the best gift is not necessarily the most expensive. Instead, it is the simple gift that only we can give. Let Epiphany remind us to offer our lives to Jesus each day.

La Epifanía del Señor El pequeño tamborilero

¿Sabías que la única razón por la que decimos que hubo tres reyes magos es porque trajeron tres regalos? La Biblia nunca dice cuántos eran ni sus nombres. Los regalos nos hablan de quienes los dan. Y estos regalos especiales (oro, incienso y mirra) nos dicen mucho.

Cuando un rey visitaba o enviaba un embajador a otro, le daba un regalo de oro para demostrar que reconocía el reinado del otro. Así que, el primer regalo de los reyes magos nos demuestra que reconocieron a Jesús como Rey. El segundo regalo es un tipo de incienso, que se utilizaba en tiempos de Jesús para adorar a Dios. Así que, este regalo demuestra que los Reyes Magos están rindiendo homenaje a la divinidad de Jesús. El regalo de la mirra es un óleo que se utiliza para ungir a los moribundos. Nos recuerda del sufrimiento y la muerte de Jesús en la cruz.

Entonces, ¿qué dones tenemos para Jesús? Quizás los reyes magos nos pueden dar una pista. Si reconocemos a Jesús como rey, tal vez un regalo mejor que el oro sería prometerle obediencia. Cada día podemos prometer vivir nuestra vocación lo mejor posible, amar a quienes nos rodean y perdonar a quienes nos lastiman.

En lugar de quemar incienso, una mejor manera de rendir homenaje a la divinidad de Jesús sería tomarse un tiempo para rezar durante el día. Algunas personas pueden asistir a Misa diaria, otras dedican tiempo a la adoración ante el Santísimo, o incluso unos momentos de su tiempo de almuerzo para rezar el rosario.

En cuanto al don de la mirra, podemos regalarle a Jesús las cruces que cargamos todos los días. Cuando aceptamos el sufrimiento en nuestras vidas, especialmente lo que es causado por nuestros pecados, nos entregamos a Jesús como él se entregó por nosotros en la cruz.

La canción "Little Drummer Boy" (el pequeño tamborilero) nos recuerda que el mejor regalo no es necesariamente el más caro. Más bien, es un regalo sencillo que sólo nosotros podemos dar. Que la Epifanía nos recuerde ofrecer nuestras vidas a Jesús todos los días.
